

Directions from North West Valley, Arizona:



Take this route if you live several miles north of the 101 freeway. Proceed to I-17 and take it north to the Verde Valley (approx 67 miles from the 101 interchange). In 2003 construction started in the Verde Valley. (Note as you descend the rim there are some very sharp corners, please follow the posted speed limits on these corners). Therefore take the Highway 260 exit. Turn right onto Highway 260. You will drive about 36 miles on highway 260 until you come to a stop sign. Turn right onto Highway 260/87.

Recommendation: Because of daily wildlife migrations travel 1 hour around sunset and around sunrise requires extra caution. The elk, deer, turkey, javalina, and other animals tend to migrate during these time periods to eat and drink.
